
Agenda Item 1 – Roll Call


NEW BUSINESS

A. Approval: for renting the pressurized water tank to take the place of or do the job of the water tower for the duration of the cleaning, maintenance and painting. The project will be for an approximate three-to-four week period. Lengthy discussion followed with Council Member Westfall making motion to approve renting the pressurized water tank. Motion was seconded by Council Member B. Brown. Vote indicated: “AYE” All. Motion: Carried

B. Approval: of Cindy Moran as interim part-time City Clerk/Treasurer. After discussion, Council Member R. Brown made motion to hire Cindy Moran as interim part-time City Clerk/Treasurer. Motion was seconded by Council Member Whisler, Vote indicated: “AYE” B. Brown, R. Brown, Whisler. “NAY” Westfall. Reasons for “NAY” vote include lack of current programs knowledge, spending money for a temporary position, giving Moran the “City Clerk/Treasurer” title instead of administrative assistant because she hasn’t been around and that power control when she hasn’t been in the office is a concern.
